



Firm gains office space

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High Street Equity Advisors, LLC, a Boston-based real estate investment firm has acquired office space in the Twin Cities metropolitan area, including in Eden Prairie and Edina.

High Street purchased a total of eight properties in Minneapolis ranging from office buildings and warehouses to industrial buildings.

In Eden Prairie, the firm bought Golden Triangle Technology Center, a 91,971-square-foot single story office building that was constructed in 1997. The property is 100 percent leased to four tenants, including Methodist Hospital, Pitney Bowes and Rasmussen College.

Also in Eden Prairie's Golden Triangle near Edina, the firm also bought structures at 6925 and 6955 Washington Ave. Both industrial buildings located within an established industrial park. The buildings are currently 96 percent leased to 11 tenants.

High Street Equity Advisors also acquired buildings in Brooklyn Park, Eagan and Roseville.
